Over the last two years, the partnership has worked across Latvia, Greece, Italy, Spain, France, Cyprus, and Bulgaria to equip older adults (55+) and adult educators with the skills they need to navigate today's digital world with confidence and safety.

From spotting misinformation to protecting personal data and making responsible choices online, the project has helped participants think critically, stay safe, and engage positively in the digital space.
