The transnational Learning Teaching Training Activity (LTTA) was successfully completed in Tallinn, Estonia, from September 9 to 12, 2025.

### - A focus on Digital governance

Delegations from all six consortium countries (Italy, Cyprus, Bulgaria, Greece, Norway, and Estonia) gathered in Estonia for this unique experience.
